**TOTAL ROTOR**

1. Pilots from any country are welcome to submit their best flight videos.
2. All contestants must register a pilot account on Total Rotor in order to submit their videos.
3. All videos must be submitted through [www.totalrotor.com](http://www.totalrotor.com) and labelled under the "Drone Freestyle Filmfest" category. Only videos uploaded to the 'Drone Freestyle Filmfest' category will be considered for judging.
4. No entry fee is applicable for submission.
5. All videos submitted must not be longer than 2 minutes. Videos longer than 2 minutes may not be considered for judging.
6. Each contestant is allowed to submit a maximum of 3 videos. However, only 1 video can proceed to the final stage.
7. Should more than 3 videos be submitted, only the first 3 videos will be judged.
8. Videos must include the following:
  - a) Insert the contest logo as the first frame of the video.
  - b) Add "DFF" into the title of your submission
  - c) Include a full shot of the drone used in the video
9. Videos will be judged based on the following elements, but not limited to:
  - a) Artistic impression – e.g. pairing of moves/stunts and music to the environment
  - b) Execution/control – e.g. setup, connection and finishing of moves; cleanliness in control
  - c) Difficulty – e.g. difficulty of stunt/trick(s) in relation to environment or routine
  - d) Variety – e.g. showcase a variety of tricks and how they string together
  - e) Overall entertainment value
10. Contest begins on 8<sup>th</sup> September 2017. Submissions must be made before 10<sup>th</sup> October 2017, 2359hrs (GMT +8)
11. Upon closure of contest, Total Rotor will shortlist the top 5 videos for the final stage. These 5 videos will be shared on Total Rotor's Facebook page by 15<sup>th</sup> October 2017.

12. Once the top 5 videos have been shared on Total Rotor's Facebook page, the finalists have 7 days to garner the most number of 'likes' on their videos through Total Rotor's Facebook page
13. The 3 videos with the most number of likes at the end of 7 days (21<sup>st</sup> October 2017, 2359hrs) will emerge as winners and will walk away with attractive prizes from Total Rotor.
14. Top three (3) flight videos with the highest number of LIKES will be awarded prizes valued at SGD\$346, SGD\$192 & SGD\$142 respectively.
15. By submitting your video, you are deemed to have authorised and granted permission to exhibit your work across all Total Rotor and its partner platforms. You accept full legal responsibility for the intellectual property contained within your video and that you have cleared all contents of the film with the respective copyright holders prior to submission.

All winners will be contacted via email by 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2017. Please include your contact number during registration as an alternative contact method.

16. Criteria for non-acceptance of video include, excessive or gratuitous violence and nudity.
17. Total Rotor reserves the rights to remove inappropriate content without notification.
18. Total Rotor reserves the right to modify any of these rules and regulations as required.
